

# TPWU Official Convention Call

## Texas Postal Workers Union /TPWU Auxiliary State Convention 32<sup>nd</sup> Biennial TPWU Convention June 23- 25, 2011

Members of the Texas Postal Workers Union, AFL-CIO will convene in **Dallas, Texas** at 10:00 am, **Thursday, June 23, 2011** through **Saturday, June 25, 2011** for the **32<sup>nd</sup> TPWU Biennial Convention**. The official convention headquarters will be at the **Sheraton Dallas Hotel , 400 North Olive Street, Dallas, Texas 75201**. Convention Registration Fee will be \$85.00 until **May 27, 2011** and the late registration fee will be \$95.00.

### Resolutions & Constitution Amendments

Resolutions and Constitution Amendments must be submitted to: **TPWU Secretary/Treasurer Jeanie Franklin, P.O. Box 1975, Lubbock TX 79408**.

Resolutions and Constitution Amendments should be typewritten and submitted in duplicate. The local Secretary should attest to resolutions and constitution amendments submitted by a local. Resolutions must contain the following information:

1. The title or subject matter.
2. The names of delegates or local sponsoring the resolution or amendment.
3. The body or text of the resolution or amendment.

**Note:** Please put only one resolution or constitution amendment on each page.

All Resolutions and Constitution Amendments will be referred to the appropriate committee. Resolutions and Constitution Amendments with the same basic subject matter will be consolidated. Consolidated resolutions or constitution amendments will bear the name of each local submitting a similar Resolutions and Constitution Amendments. All Resolutions and Constitution Amendments will be brought to the floor for a vote.

After **May 1, 2011**, Resolutions and Constitution Amendments will be accepted by the Secretary providing they are submitted in **300** copies. Those dealing with subjects not otherwise submitted will be referred to the appropriate committee. Time permitting, all resolutions submitted after **May 1, 2011** will be reported out of committee and brought to the floor for a vote.

### TPWU Election Nominations

The Texas Postal Workers Union will hold nominations and elections at the **32<sup>nd</sup> Biennial TPWU Convention** to be held at the Sheraton Dallas Hotel. Nominations for the following positions will be conducted on **Friday, June 24, 2011**:

President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Director of News Information/Editor, Clerk Craft Director, Maintenance Craft Director, Motor Vehicle Director, Legislative Aide and District Vice Presidents District #1 through # 10.

Elections will be the first order of business on **Saturday, June 25, 2011**. All offices will be for a term of two years.

Nominations for Delegate to the National Convention will also be taken at this time. The number of elected delegates shall be five (5), and one 1 deaf and hard of hearing delegate.
